MINUTES – June 8, 2026

Ordinances:

Amendments to Waupaca County Code of Ordinances - Chapter 2 - The Governing Body - Discussion and possible action on proposed recommended amendments: The committee had discussion on some proposed amendments. The committee will continue to discuss next month as no action was taken.

Structure Reorganization to remove Child Support from Corp. Counsel and move to DHS: Angela Boelter, Corporation Counsel spoke to the committee in regard to a structure reorganization of Child Support. The ask is to move the Child Support Department to fall under the DHS department instead of Corporation Counsel. This idea has already been presented to the DHS Board and will go before the Human Resources Board if recommendation is approved by this committee. **Motion:** Supr. Holtebeck moved and Supr. Will seconded the motion to release Child Support from under the direction of Corporation Counsel and move the department to be structured in the Dept. of Human Services Department and refer the changes to Human Resources. Motion carried without a negative vote.

Res.
